1. Ages are as of 1 September 2023.
2. No athlete may compete in more than 3 events ( $\mathbf{2}$ track \& $\mathbf{1}$ field or $\mathbf{1}$ track \& 2 field) and a relay.
3. No athlete may compete in both the 800 m and the 1500 m .
4. No Under 13 (or below) athlete may compete in the 300 m .
5. Track events will take priority; if there is a clash, tell the field event judge that you will be late and do the track event first. If there is a clash between two field events, inform the judges and arrange to do one after the other.
6. Three attempts allowed for each field event.
7. Three attempts allowed at each height in the high jump. A competitor may pass at any height not previously attempted and may attempt a maximum of 7 heights.
8. An athlete must complete the course, or register a valid throw or jump, to score points.
9. 50 bonus points are awarded to any League that has every able member competing in the meeting. This bonus is void should any member fail to compete.

## Record holders \& medals



- 110m hurdler Lawrence Clarke (OS 19982003) represented Great Britain at the 2012 and 2016 Olympics. He kindly presented the winners' medals at our 2010 and 2013 League Athletics Meetings.
- Tade Ojora (OS 2008-2013) is our most prolific record holder. On leaving Summer Fields in 2013 he held 20 individual records, including the 200m at all five age groups; two National Prep School Athletics Championship Hurdles Records; all three Mercia Regional Athletics Championship Hurdles Records, as well as being part of the record holding School \& National Prep School Athletics Championship Under 14 4x100m relay team. Today, fourteen of his School Records remain. His School, Regional and National Hurdles records stood until 2019 at which point a revision of event specifications condemned them all to the archives. Tade went on to Eton College where he broke all of Lawrence Clarke's hurdles records. He became the British Men's 110m Hurdles Champion in 2021, retaining the title in 2022 when he went on to represent England in the 110 m hurdles at the Commonwealth Games.
- To mark the Summer Fields $150^{\text {th }}$ Anniversary in 2014, all Record Holders were invited to present the Winner's Medals for their respective events on Sports Day. Twenty current and former pupils were able to gather for the occasion.

However, this has not diminished the high achievements of those who have had the opportunity to compete: sixteen boys qualified to compete at the Mercia Prep Schools Regional Championships. Thanks to their successes at that meeting, eleven of the squad will be representing the region at the National Prep Schools Athletics Championships on Monday 3 July, for which we wish them every success.
